

### Changes to Housing Access and Support for Singles

<p><b>1991</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Introduction of the Single Singapore Citizen Scheme under which singles aged 35 and above are able to buy resale flats but limited to 3-room and smaller flats at selected locations.</li> </ul>
<p><b>1998</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• CPF Housing Grants are extended to singles</li> </ul>
<p><b>2001</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Singles are allowed to buy 3-room and smaller resale flats in all locations</li> </ul> <p><b>2004</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Singles are allowed to buy 4- and larger resale flats in all locations</li> </ul>
<p><b>2013</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Singles are allowed to purchase new 2-room Flexi BTO flats directly from HDB</li> </ul> <p><b>2019</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Enhanced CPF Housing Grant (EHG) of up to \$40,000 in 2019 introduced for singles</li> </ul>
<p><b>2022</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Increase quota for singles applying for new 2-room Flexi flats in non-mature estates from 50% to 65%</li> </ul>
<p><b>2023</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• CPF Housing Grant (Singles) increased from \$25,000 to up to \$40,000</li> </ul>
