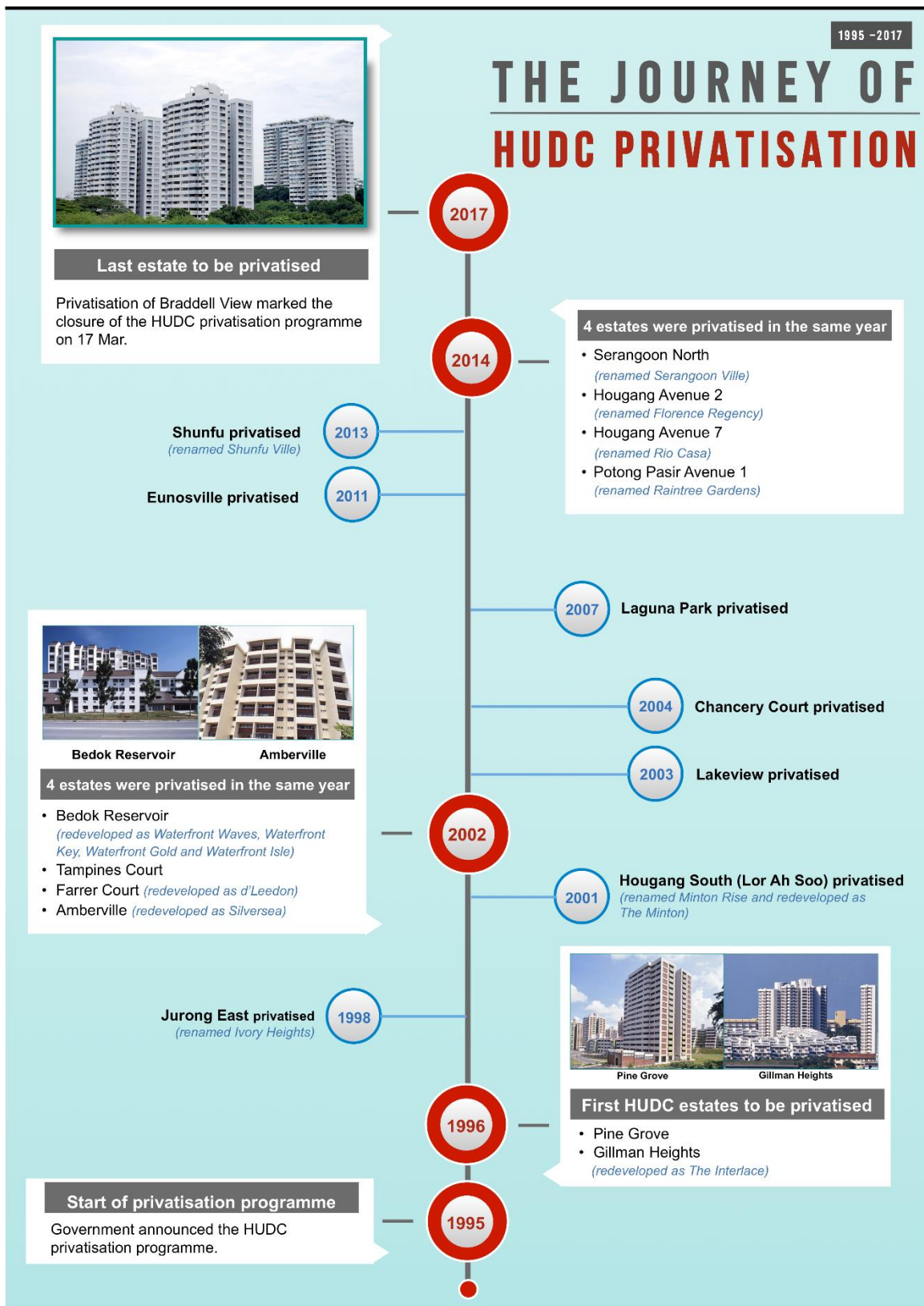


TRACING THE JOURNEY OF HUDC PRIVATISATION



MILESTONES OF HUDC PRIVATISATION

Date	Milestones
1974	Housing & Urban Development Co. (Private) Limited incorporated. Under HUDC Phases I/II, six HUDC projects were sold by Housing & Urban Development Co. (Private) Limited : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Farrer Court (redeveloped as d'Leedon) • Amberville (redeveloped as Silversea) • Lakeview • Laguna Park • Chancery Court • Braddell View
1982	HDB took over the management of the HUDC Phases I/II estates to bring them under the legislative umbrella of the H&D Act.
1984	Under HUDC Phases III/IV, 12 HUDC projects were sold by HDB : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pine Grove • Gillman Heights (redeveloped as The Interlace) • Jurong East (renamed Ivory Heights) • Hougang South (Lor Ah Soo) (renamed as Minton Rise and redeveloped as The Minton) • Bedok Reservoir (redeveloped as Waterfront Waves, Waterfront Key, Waterfront Gold and Waterfront Isle) • Eunosville* • Shunfu (renamed Shunfu Ville)* • Serangoon North (renamed Serangoon Ville) • Hougang Ave 2 (renamed Florence Regency) • Hougang Ave 7 (renamed Rio Casa) • Potong Pasir Ave 1 (renamed Raintree Gardens) • Tampines Court
1986	HUDC Phases I/II estates granted self-management under the HUDC Housing Estates Act.
1995	Government announced the HUDC privatisation programme on 24 May 1995.
1996	The first HUDC estates were privatized on 1 Nov 1996 : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pine Grove (660 units) • Gillman Heights (607 units & 1 shop) (redeveloped as The Interlace)
1998	Jurong East HUDC estate (654 units) was privatized on 1 June 1998 and subsequently renamed Ivory Heights.
2001	Hougang South (Lorong Ah Soo) (342 units) was privatised on 1 Feb 2001 (renamed as Minton Rise and redeveloped as The Minton).
2002	The following four HUDC estates were privatised in the same year :

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bedok Reservoir (583 units) on 1 Feb 2002 (redeveloped as Waterfront Waves, Waterfront Key, Waterfront Gold and Waterfront Isle) • Tampines Court (560 units) on 1 Apr 2002 • Farrer Court (618 units) on 15 Nov 2002(redeveloped as d'Leedon) • Amberville (168 units) on 16 Dec 2002(redeveloped as Silversea)
2003	Lakeview HUDC estate (240 units) was privatised on 1 Aug 2003.
2004	Chancery Court (136 units & 8 shops) was privatised on 24 May 2004.
2007	Laguna Park (516 units & 12 shops) was privatised on 16 July 2007.
2011	Eunosville (330 units) was privatised on 1 June 2011.
2013	Shunfu HUDC estate (renamed Shunfu Ville) (358 units) was privatised on 28 March 2013.
2014	<p>The following four HUDC estates were privatised in the same year:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Serangoon North (244 units) (renamed Serangoon Ville) privatised on 8 May 2014 • Hougang Avenue 2 (336 units) (renamed Florence Regency) was privatised on 22 May 2014 • Hougang Avenue 7 (286 units) (renamed Rio Casa) was privatised on 13 June 2014 • Potong Pasir Avenue 1 (175 units) (renamed Raintree Gardens) was privatised on 1 July 2014
2017	Braddell View (918 units & 2 shops) is the last HUDC estate to be privatised on 17 March 2017, marking the closure of the HUDC privatisation programme.
